The formation of the Society of Friends of St John's Cathedral was announced by Bishop Crispian at the Chrism Mass in 1999 following the refurbishment of the Cathedral in anticipation of the year 2000 'Jubilee'. The Cathedral Dean is the Society President.

The Society was able to donate £21,000 to the Organ Fund, £9,000 towards construction of the Cathedral Treasury and £3,500 for new vestments and the production of the Cathedral information leaflet *The first 125 years*.




